

2 Chronicles 7:14 Prayer Guide Week 1

Week 1 – Called by the name of the Lord

Sunday

If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
2 Chronicles 7:14

Lord, we declare this day that you are our God and we are your people. By the holy and precious blood of your only begotten son, Jesus Christ, we are people called by your name.

Monday

If my people who are called by my name...

Meditate: What are the names that others have called you? By what names have you called yourself. By what name is God calling you? In Isaiah 56:3, the Lord forbade the foreigner, the outcast, and the eunuch, the dry tree, to speak of themselves by the names that others had given them. “Do not let the foreigner joined to the Lord say ...” and “Do not let the eunuch say...” It is time to stop listening to the old names the lies spoken over us and receive the name of the Lord.

Pray: Lord, forgive me for listening to and believing the names given to me by the world and the evil one. From this point forward, I will not call myself by those other names. Lord, open my heart, my mind, and my eyes to receive your name. Revel to me your name for me, that name which is everlasting and will not be cut off. (Isaiah 56:5, John 1:12-13) Record any names the Lord gives you.

Tuesday

Pray for my family members by name:

Lord, you have revealed your name to us that we might have your love within us. (John 17:7). Lord, reveal your name over each member of my family (pray over them by name). Lord, tear off any false labels that they have taken on and label them with your name.

(If necessary, repent of any false labels that you may have given them or helped establish on them.) Record any names the Lord gives you for your family members.

Wednesday

Pray for church leaders by name:

Lord, through Jesus Christ _____ is part of your chosen race, your royal priesthood, your holy nation, _____ is one of your own. Increase _____’s faith to walk in your name, that your name may be established in _____. Empower _____ to proclaim your mighty acts and witness your name to others.

Thursday

Pray for members of the River and My Father’s House by name:

Lord, through Jesus Christ _____ is part of your chosen race, your royal priesthood, your holy nation, _____ is one of your own. Increase _____’s faith to walk in your name, that your name may be established in _____. Empower _____ to proclaim your mighty acts and witness your name to others.

Friday

Pray for the corporate body of believers at The River & My Father’s House

Lord, make your home among us (in the River and My Father’s House). Lord, dwell with us as our God; we are your people. Lord, we long for you, yourself to be with us. Lord, we will worship you, we will see your face, and your name will be on our foreheads. (Revelation 21:3, 22:3-4)

Saturday

Lord, through the free gift of the blood of Jesus Christ we are your people and you are our God. We receive your name (*name the Lord has revealed*) and we walk in your truth.

Week 2 - Humble Themselves

Sunday

If my people who are called by my name will **humble** themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
2 Chronicles 7:14

Lord Jesus Christ, teach us Your ways that we will walk in Your truth. Lord open our eyes, our hearts, and our minds to learning to live the truth of these words. We no longer want to be satisfied with just the words. Lord, we are desperate for Your presence, we are desperate for Your love teach us Your steps, Your actions, Your plans, Your way of living that we will know how to humble ourselves before You and that nothing (not thoughts, not actions, not habits, not lies ...) nothing within us will strive against You and Your ways.

Monday

The Lord is asking me the following questions: Will you humble yourself before me or will you continue to tarry another day? Will you humble yourself before me or will you continue to tarry until I humble you?

Hosea 10:12

Sow for yourselves righteousness; reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground, for it is time to seek the Lord, till He comes and rains righteousness on you.

“Break up your fallow ground.” This is our call to humility. Just as a farmer breaks up the ground before the rain in order to let the rain penetrate and soak the ground, I need to break up the ground of my heart and remove anything that is setting itself up against the Lord. So that when He rains down His righteousness, it will penetrate my very core and not just run-off the hardened surface of my pride and my disobedience. What am I esteeming so highly that I have created a wall against the rain of the Lord in my life? I say the words and call Him Lord, but have I made myself a living sacrifice before Him?

Have I made my heart an alter in the Name of the Lord, a place of never ending praise?

Each day this week pray the prayer from Sunday for yourself and spend time before the Lord asking the following questions, write down your answers.

1. What am I esteeming above (as evidenced by my actions, my time, my words, and my thoughts) the Lord Jesus Christ?
2. What are my excuses, my rationalizations, what are my whys for this behavior?
3. Will I humble myself and repent or will I allow another day to pass me by?

Prayer: *Teach us your ways oh Lord that we will walk in your truth.*

Study the life of perfect Humility

Humility is the exact opposite of pride and it is not love for lack of humility is vainglory. Those who practice humility, seek the Kingdom of God first (Matt 6:33), think more highly of others than they do of themselves (Phil. 2:3) and put the well-being of others ahead of their own well-being (Phil. 2:4). Most importantly, humbling our selves before the Lord, means to put away, pull out, esteem lowly anything within our lives, our actions, our thoughts, and our hearts that raises itself above or against the perfect will of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord Jesus Christ taught others about the importance of humility and practiced it flawlessly in His own life.

I. Jesus taught others about humility.

- A. He taught His disciples to humble themselves as little children (Matthew 18:1-4).
- B. He taught His disciples to be ministers and servants instead of kings and princes (Matthew 20:25-28).

- C. He taught His disciples to be servants instead of masters (Matthew 23:10-12).
- D. He taught His disciples to be servants of all to be first and greatest of all (Mark 9:33-35).
- E. He taught His disciples to be least of all to be the greatest of all (Luke 9:46-48).
- F. He taught His disciples to take the lowest position to reach the highest position (Luke 14:7-11).

II. Jesus practiced humility.

- A. He took upon Himself the form of a servant (Phil. 2:7).
- B. He was made in the likeness of men (Phil. 2:7).
- C. He was found in fashion as a man (Phil. 2:8).
- D. He voluntarily became poor for the sake of God's elect (2 Cor. 8:9).
- E. He was born in a stable and laid in a manger (Luke 2:7).
- F. He was raised in a poor family (Luke 2:22-24).
- G. He grew up in the wicked place called Nazareth (John 1:46).
- H. He had nowhere to lay His head (Luke 9:58).
- I. He was a friend to publicans and sinners (Matthew 11:19).
- J. He allowed Himself to be anointed by a sinful woman (Luke 7:36-39,44-48).
- K. He washed His disciples' feet (John 13:3-5, 12-17).
- L. He became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross (Phil. 2:8).
- M. He was buried in a borrowed tomb (Matthew 27:57-60).

Saturday

Hosea 10:12

Sow for yourselves righteousness; reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground, for it is time to seek the Lord, till He comes and rains righteousness on you.

Declare Hosea 10:12 over the corporate body of the River & My Father's House

Week 3 - Pray

Sunday Corporate Prayer

If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and **PRAY** and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

2 Chronicles 7:14

Lord, we recognize that you have called us to relationship with you! We acknowledge and confess that we do not know how to do this well! You have called us friends yet we spend so little time with you! You have told us everything we need to know in your word yet we act like we don't know you. So Lord, we come as your disciples came and we humbly ask you to teach us. Teach us how to communicate with you! **TEACH US HOW TO PRAY!**

"Our Father which are in Heaven, Holy is your name?

Your Kingdom Come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil

For thine is the Kingdom, the Power, the Glory Forever, Amen."

Monday (Personal Reflection)

Our Father which are in Heaven, Holy is your name...

As you begin each day, pray the Lords Prayer all the way through.

Meditate: Commit today to gaining a revelation of the Holiness of God. He is the Great I AM, the uncreated, creating God. He is the name above all names. He is the one to whom all creation will one day bow before (this includes YOU!). His name was so holy that in the Old Testament they could not write it or say it for fear of judgment or death.

Take a moment to repent for treating God's name as something common.

Pray: Pray for a revelation of the AWE of God and His Holiness. (you may find yourself needing to go to your knees or prostrate yourself)

Tuesday (Pray for my family members by name)

Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven...

God's Kingdom is ruled by The King (Jesus). Before God's Kingdom can come on the earth, it must first come in me! Which means King Self must surrender to King Jesus! He will not share his throne. The King demands total surrender of our lives. In fact until we recognize that our lives are not our own, we will never experience God's full purpose for our lives.

God's will is that He would receive praise from His creation (you and I) God's will begins with our love for Him and we show our love through our obedience.

Repent for yourself and for your family for serving King Self. Repent for specific areas the Holy Spirit shows you where you have not surrendered to the Lordship of Jesus. Repent for the things in your life that do not give glory and praise to God. What will you do to change?

Pray Begin by praising God and recognizing his majesty and authority. Then pray for God's Kingdom to come manifest in you and each member of your family.

Wednesday (Pray for church leaders by name)

Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven...

Repeat the process from Tuesday for the leadership of the River Ministries.

Pray Begin with praise and thanksgiving that God establishes his leaders. Pray for a spirit of wisdom and revelation to be on the leadership and every decision. Pray that the fear of the Lord would come upon the leadership. Pray for true humility and surrender to be the foundation of leadership. Pray for future leaders to take their place in our group. Pray for the Kingdom of God to come in each leader and their family (increase in unity and intimacy in their home)

Thursday (*Pray for community of the River and My Father's House by name*)

Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven...

Repeat the process from Tuesday for the leadership of the River Ministries.

Pray Begin with praise, thank God for giving us this community of believers and ask His blessing upon them. Pray that the River Fellowships and My Fathers House will truly become the Church of the Bible. Pray that God's Kingdom would come in each person so that when we come together we might bring God's Kingdom into our homes and workplaces.

Friday (*Pray for the Community of the River Ministries and those God places on your heart*)

Give us this day our daily Bread, and forgive our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil...

It is humbling to think that God tells us to make our requests known even before we come to him for forgiveness! (Meditate on this as you pray)

Pray for requests:

- A revelation of a surrendered life for every member of the community.
- Courage to "Go Through" the situations in our lives and to have faith that God is on the other side.
- Mandy Hess as she works to open Solomon's Porch (new manager)
- Cory Davis who is doing the build out of our space. Favor and timely completion
- Christie Millette as she raises support for her ministry in Israel

Pray for Forgiveness

- A spirit of repentance to fall in our community marked by true Godly sorrow.
- Ask the Lord to search your heart and to reveal to you any area of unforgiveness. (as He does deal with it biblically)

- Continued revelation and practice of the teaching on How to Repair Broken and Damaged Relationships.

Pray for strength to overcome temptation

Remember that God is the one who leads us from Temptation; we can not do it on our own.

- Pray for eyes to see the plans of the enemy against you, your family and the church. Then pray the blood of Jesus over everything the Spirit shows you.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would expose the idols in your life and in the life of His Church. As they are exposed, repent of them, seek forgiveness and create a strategy to walk free from those idols.

Saturday

For Thine is the Kingdom and the Power and the Glory Forever, Amen.

It is not an accident that the prayer Jesus taught us to pray begins and ends in praise and worship to God and recognizing His authority and leadership.

Use this day to praise Him with your words, thoughts and deeds. Listen to worship music and praise him.

Thank Him for his creation and for your life.

Tell someone about what the Lord has done for you!

Hug your family (if they are close) or call them on the phone and tell them that you Love them!

Serve someone today with no expectation of anything in return.

When you go to bed, kneel, bow and pray. Thank God for the many blessings and the trials. Tell God you Love Him.

Come to Church Sunday expecting God to meet you and to meet us! Believe for bigger things! Be ready to bless someone who God puts in your path.

Week 4 - Seek My Face**Sunday Corporate Prayer**

If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and **SEEK MY FACE** and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

2 Chronicles 7:14

This is a week to seek the face of God, not his strength, not his power, not his will. Use this week as a time to be awed by the majesty and glory of God! Ask the Lord for a hunger this week for a revelation of God's identity.

Pray

Lord, we recognize that we seek many things in our lives. We seek recognition, acceptance, and love! We seek success, status and honor. We even seek your power! But Lord we confess that we do not seek your face. Lord you are the lifter of our head! It is in your face that we find your glory.

Monday (Personal Reflection)

My heart says of you "Seek his face!" Your face Lord I will seek.

-- Psalms 27:8

Meditate: Seeking God's face is all about relationship! What kind of relationship do you have with Christ? What do you seek most, His face or His hand?

And all of us, with unveiled faces, seeing the glory of the Lord as though reflected in a mirror, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another, for this comes from the Lord, the Spirit. 2 Corinthians 3:18

We are called to be like Christ. When you think of the face of God, what kind of characteristics come to mind (make a list).

Pray: First repent to the Lord for ways in which you have sought God's hand (works) over His face (presence). Spend your time in prayer seeking a revelation of God's love for you. Hear these words in prayer, "You are my Son/Daughter in whom I am well pleased."

Tuesday (Pray for my family members by name)

For this reason, I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant (Family name), according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man; so that Christ may dwell in (Family name) hearts through faith; and that (Family name), being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that (Family name) may be filled up to all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen. (Ephesians 3:14-21)

Pray: Seek God's face for your family! Pray the Ephesians passage above and insert your family name in each area and/or insert each member of your family in each spot.

Wednesday (Pray for church leaders by name)

Repeat the process from Tuesday for the leadership of the River Ministries. Put each name of those in leadership in the Ephesians text. Let the Holy Spirit lead you as you pray through the word. Be ready to write down any revelation the Lord gives you and share it as you are lead.

Pray**Thursday (Pray for community of the River and My Father's House by name)**

Repeat the process from Tuesday for the members of our community. Put each name of those in leadership in the Ephesians text. Let the Holy Spirit lead you as you pray through the word. Be ready to write down any revelation the Lord gives you and share it as you are lead.

Friday (Pray for Church in our city, nation and world)

Ask the Lord to put on your heart those around you, neighbors, co-workers, strangers, and government and marketplace leaders. Write their names in the margins. Then pray Ephesians 3 over them.

Repeat the process from Tuesday for the members of our community. Put each name of those in leadership in the Ephesians text. Let the Holy Spirit lead you as you pray through the word. Be ready to write down any revelation the Lord gives you and share it as you are lead.

Saturday

Seeking the Face of God is one of the beginning steps in a surrendered life! Psalm 27 is David's "One Thing!" and it need to be ours. Everything else flows out of this. This is your prayer. Read it slowly and read it over several times. Stop where the Holy Spirits pricks you and meditate on each part.

Psalm 27 (amplified) [A Psalm] of David.

1THE LORD is my Light and my Salvation--whom shall I fear or dread? The Lord is the Refuge and Stronghold of my life--of whom shall I be afraid?

2When the wicked, even my enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

3Though a host encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, [even then] in this will I be confident.

4One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon **the beauty** [the sweet attractiveness and the delightful loveliness] of the Lord and to meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple.

5For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent will He hide me; He will set me high upon a rock.

6And now shall my head be lifted up above my enemies round about me; in His tent I will offer sacrifices and shouting of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord.

7Hear, O Lord, when I cry aloud; have mercy and be gracious to me and answer me!

8You have said, Seek My face [inquire for and require My presence as your vital need]. My heart says to You, Your face (Your presence), Lord, will I seek, inquire for, and require [of necessity and on the authority of Your Word].

9Hide not Your face from me; turn not Your servant away in anger, You Who have been my help! Cast me not off, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation!

10Although my father and my mother have forsaken me, yet the Lord will take me up [adopt me as His child].

11Teach me Your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain and even path because of my enemies [those who lie in wait for me].

12Give me not up to the will of my adversaries, for false witnesses have risen up against me; they breathe out cruelty and violence.

13[What, what would have become of me] had I not believed that I would see the Lord's goodness in the land of the living!

14Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord.

Come to Church Sunday expecting God to meet you and to meet us! Believe for bigger things! Be ready to bless someone who God puts in your path.

Week 5 – Turn from their wicked ways...

Sunday Corporate Prayer

If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and **TURN FROM THEIR WICKED WAYS**, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
2 Chronicles 7:14

Are you ready to grow the foundation under your feet? This is a week we will focus on **turning** (repentance). As we seek to come into the presence of God we often come face to face with our own depravity and sin. What we do with our sin as it is exposed is critical to God's Kingdom coming in our lives, in our families and in our sphere of influence.

Pray Lord I pray that you might give me the strength through your Holy Spirit to turn from the things in my life that do not glorify you. Grant me courage to look at myself in the mirror you hold before me. Let me not justify or make excuses for my actions that you call sin. I recognize that I do not have the ability to change the thoughts, actions, attitudes and words of others, but I do have the strength through your Holy Spirit to respond as Christ. You have called me to be like your son and like your son is how I long to be!

Monday (Personal Reflection)

4Or are you [so blind as to] trifle with and presume upon and despise and underestimate the wealth of His kindness and forbearance and long suffering patience? Are you unmindful or actually ignorant [of the fact] that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repent (to change your mind and inner man to accept God's will)?(amplified)

Romans 2:4

Meditate: Do you truly understand how much God hates sin and the extent He went to in order to give you and me a way to walk free of sin? Do you understand that there are only two things that can pay the penalty for your sins – your eternal suffering in the lake of fire or accepting and receiving the sacrificial suffering and death of God's son Jesus on your behalf! Have you ever stopped to consider that the gruesome death of Jesus Christ on the cross is an act of God's kindness to you! When rejecting the kindness of God what are you actually rejecting?

Pray: It would be foolishness to begin this week without seeking God in repentance. After reading the scripture above and meditating on the thoughts, in what ways have you unmindfully and ignorantly (or mindfully and with knowledge) rejected the kindness of God? Repent for those areas revealed.

Tuesday (The way to Repentance)

When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment.

John 16:8

13"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. 14But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

Matthew 7:13-14

10Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

2 Corinthians 7:10

Meditate: Repentance is the way through the narrow gate that leads to eternal life in the Kingdom of God! We must understand this concept as foundational. The problem we find is that people would rather break relationship than ever admit they are wrong. God knows this and has given us the Holy Spirit to do a supernatural work in convicting us of our sin, righteousness and judgment. Without the working of the Holy Spirit I do not believe anyone would truly repent. Godly sorrow comes when we see ourselves, our situation and/or others through the eyes of God. It is a gift from God and should be sought after.

Pray: Pray for the humility to repent. Pursue the narrow gate no matter the cost to self. Ask the Holy Spirit for Godly sorrow.

Wednesday (Unrepentance keeps us from God)

2In which at one time you walked [habitually]. You were following the course and fashion of this world [were under the sway of the tendency of this present age], following the prince of the power of the air. [You were obedient to and under the control of] the [demon] spirit that still constantly works in the sons of disobedience [the careless, the rebellious, and the unbelieving, who go against the purposes of God].
(amplified)

Ephesians 2:2



2 Chronicles 7:14 Prayer Guide Week 5

Meditate: Unrepentant sin gives Satan and his demons legal access to your life. God has given us a way to close the door on sin and Satan in our lives. But we must be willing to honestly examine the areas of sin in our lives and then deal with them in a biblical manor. Are there any areas in your life that you are holding on to sinful actions, thoughts or attitudes?

Pray: Pray through the different areas of your life and ask the Lord to reveal any relationships that are not in order. Ask for the Holy Spirit to reveal to you any ways in which your thoughts, actions or attitudes may be sin.

Thursday (Repentance and Forgiveness release God's Power)

19 Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about whatever [anything and everything] they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Mathew 18:19

Meditate: The word for agree actually means to be in total harmony with no discord, friction, conflict or strife about anything. It does not mean agreeing on everything, but rather where there are disagreements there is no break in relationship. It is an attitude of the heart. When you walk in true agreement with another person, God promises to grant you requests (release his power). This is most important in your home with your family. What areas in your family relationships is there discord or strife, resentment, criticism or bitterness? You may not recognize anything in the moment, but ask the Lord if there is anything in your history that was not dealt with biblically.

Pray: Go to God in prayer for each member of your **family**. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you any areas where you are holding criticism, condemnation or rejection toward a family member. Do not be quick to pass this over. As the Holy Spirit gives you revelations go to God in repentance and forgiveness first and then turn to those who you hold an offense toward and ask for their forgiveness for your sinful reactions and responses. (This is not a time to dump on people about what they may or may not have done)

Friday (Releasing Power in every area of your life)

Repeat the process from Thursday focusing on relationships outside of your family. Consider the workplace and friends. What about relationships within the church, pastors, leaders or those who should have represented Christ in your life.

Pray:

Saturday (Pray for Church in our city, nation and world)

9 The Lord does not delay and is not tardy or slow about what He promises, according to some people's conception of slowness, but He is long-suffering (extraordinarily patient) toward you, not desiring that any should perish, but that all should turn to repentance.

2 Peter 3:9

Meditate: Practicing biblical repentance can be one of the hardest things we do! It requires by its very nature a surrender of self. We can not repent with pride in our heart. God knows this challenge and is extraordinarily patient with us. He is motivated by LOVE! Reflect today on God's abundant love and patience over you. But we must also recognize that we can not test His patience against our own pride and stubbornness. After this weeks study and prayer if there are areas that God has touched on that you are still wrestling with, do not give up, persevere in the journey of surrender. How badly do you want the freedom that repentance brings?

Pray: Celebrate and recognize God's love and kindness. Rejoice that our God is long-suffering over you. Cry out for God's mercy in the midst of your journey to surrender. Pray that daily God would give you a sensitive spirit toward repentance and forgiveness.

Week 6 – God will hear from Heaven

Sunday Corporate Prayer

If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then **WILL I HEAR FROM HEAVEN** and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Pray

Lord, how awesome it is to know that we have a loving God in Heaven who will Hear our prayers. You have provided the Way, the pure and Holy Blood of Your Son, to hear our prayers. We believe that You do hear us when we pray.

Monday (Personal Reflection)

This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him

Meditate: Throughout II Chronicles 6, King Solomon in dedicating the temple prays to God asking Him to “hear from heaven”. Solomon pleads to God to “hear from heaven and act”, “hear from heaven and forgive” (this one repeated several times), “hear from heaven and do”, “hear from heaven and uphold” and “God, may your eyes be open and your ears attentive to the prayers offered in this place”. God answered Solomon’s prayer with the dream and words to him found in II Chronicles 7 saying, “I will hear from Heaven ... if” We have spent the past weeks exploring the conditions of God’s “if” for Him to hear our prayers...

His People – “If My people ... called by My Name”

Humble --“If my people ... humble themselves”

Pray --“If my people ... pray”

Seek --“If my people ... seek my face”

Repent --“If my people ... turn from their wicked ways”

Do I believe God will Hear my prayers?

Pray: First make sure you have met the conditions of God’s “if”. Then ask God to reveal to you His will: Lord, what is on Your heart for me? Open my eyes to see and my ears to hear. (*Spend time listening and making a list of what you hear*). Then pray with confidence the promises that God has revealed to you.

Tuesday (Pray for my family members by name)

Pray

Bless the Lord oh my soul and remember all His benefits. Who pardons all your iniquities? Who redeems your life from the pit? Who has not dealt with you according to your sins nor rewarded you according to your iniquities? Who has removed your transgressions from you as far as the east is from the west? It is You and only You Lord, My God and My Father, who has done these great and merciful deeds for me. You have established Your throne in the heavens and Your sovereignty rules over all. Bless the Lord oh my soul.

Monday (Personal Reflection)

If we [freely] admit that we have sinned and confess our sins, He is faithful and just (true to His own nature and promises) and will forgive our sins [dismiss our lawlessness] and [continuously] cleanse us from all unrighteousness [everything not in conformity to His will in purpose, thought, and action].

-- I John 1:9 (AMP)

Meditate: When we biblically repent of our sins and turn from our wicked way, God is true to His own nature and promises to and will forgive our sins. We must start accepting this truth and walking out in the thankfulness of Christ's sacrifice for us. The Liar would have us continue to stay bound in the pit of our guilt and sin. We need to resist his attempts to hold us in guilt and respond to him with the truth – "I have confessed to God and repented of this sin in Jesus Name. I have accepted the underserved payment of Christ's blood on my behalf and I am no

longer guilty and I refuse your accusations. Christ is master of this house, take it up with Him. Be gone in Jesus Name!"

Make a list of any sins for which you have repented and for which you still feel guilty? Verify you have confessed and repented of these sins. Then for each one say the above confession and repeat it these words every time the Enemy attempts to lay guilt on you. And learn to walk in the freedom of Christ's forgiveness.
